**Minimum Total credits - 265**

The Honors student must complete 270 credits with at least a 90% overall average. He should demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively in written and oral presentations. He should score at least 22 on the ACT or 1000 on the SAT-I, and 12.9 GE on a standardized achievement test. Honors students may graduate as soon as all requirements are satisfied.
